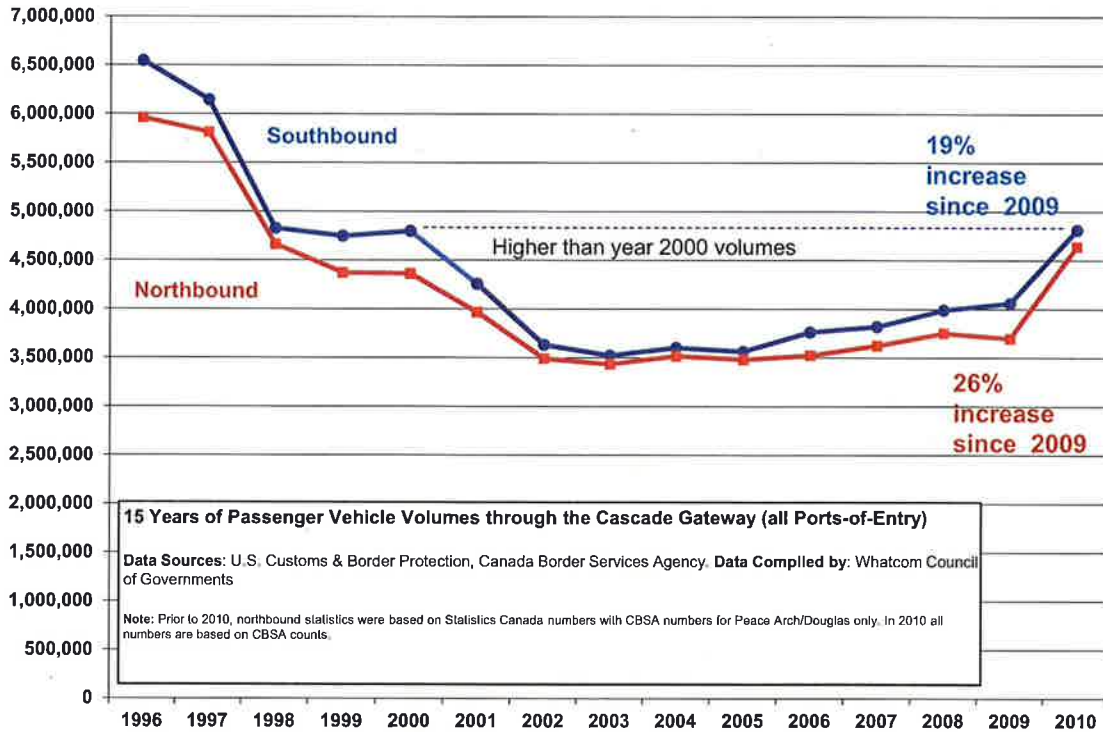

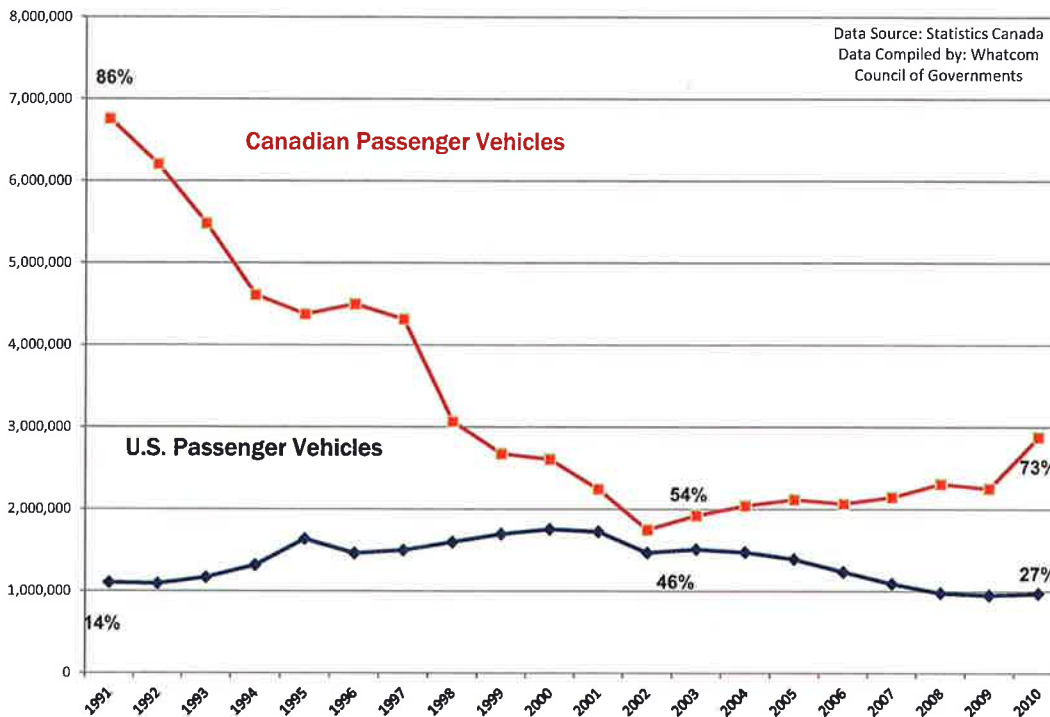
15 Years of Passenger Volumes

All 4 POEs, 2010

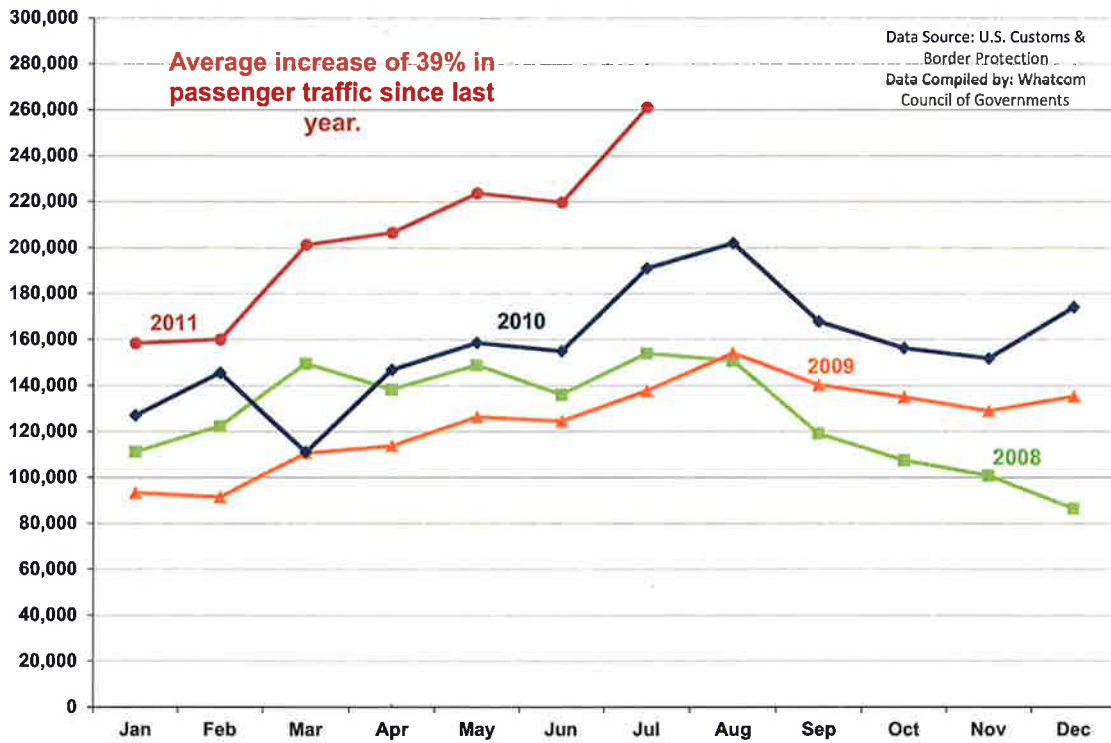


U.S. vs. Canadian Traffic

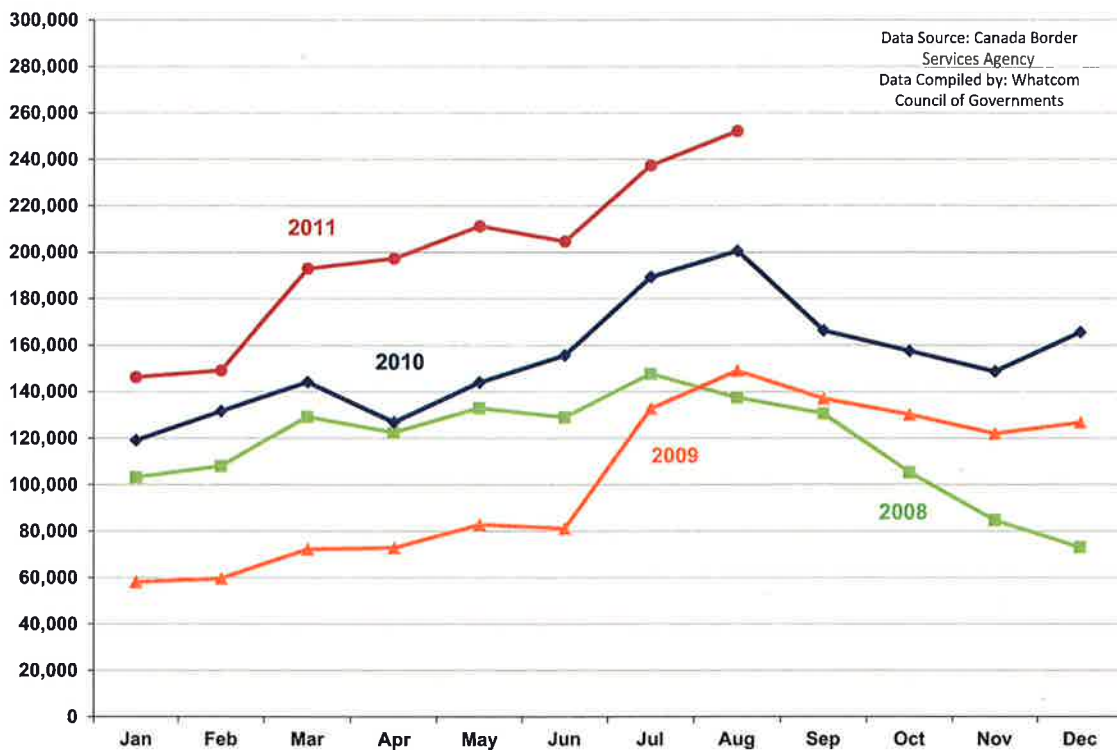
Northbound, all 4 POEs, 2010

Northbound Douglas Monthly Volumes



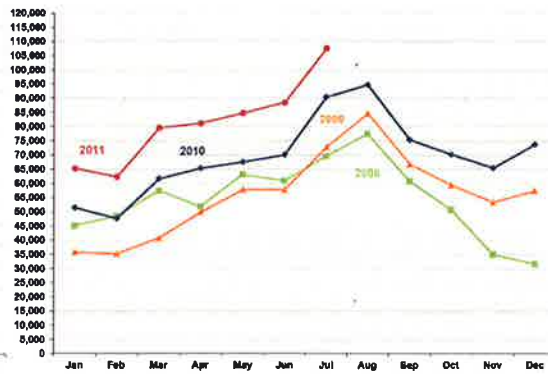

Slight increase from last year



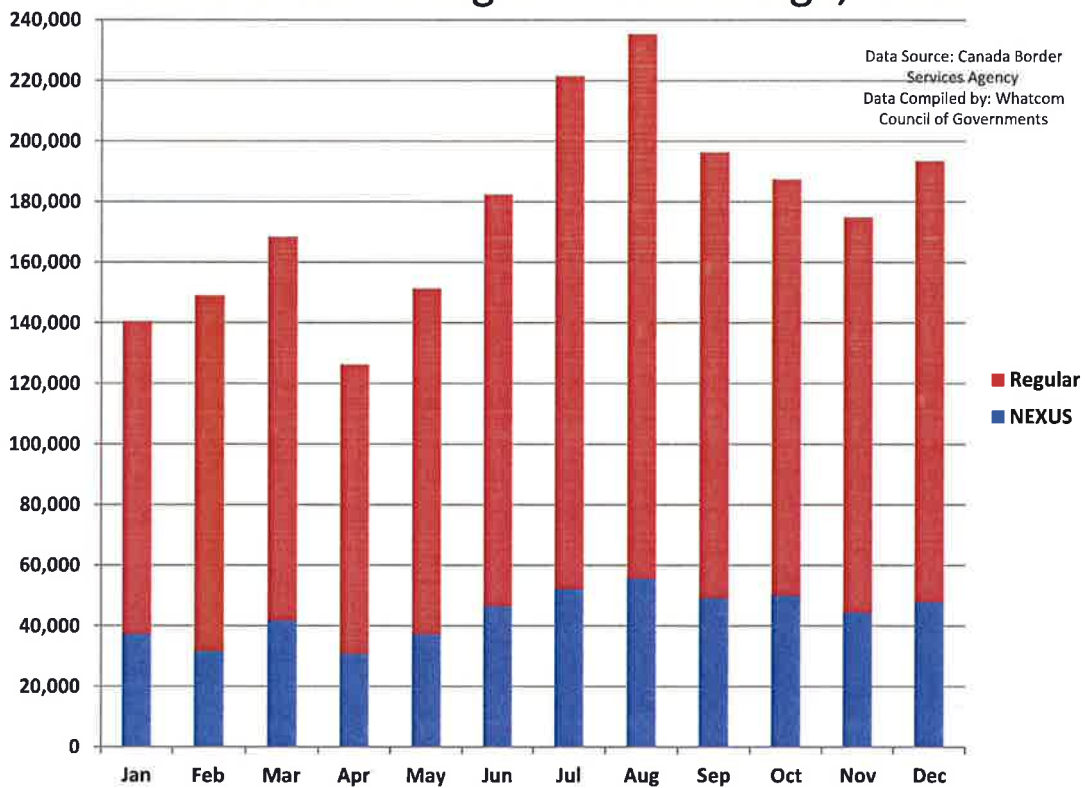
Sumas

Average increase of 26% in passenger traffic at Sumas southbound since last year.

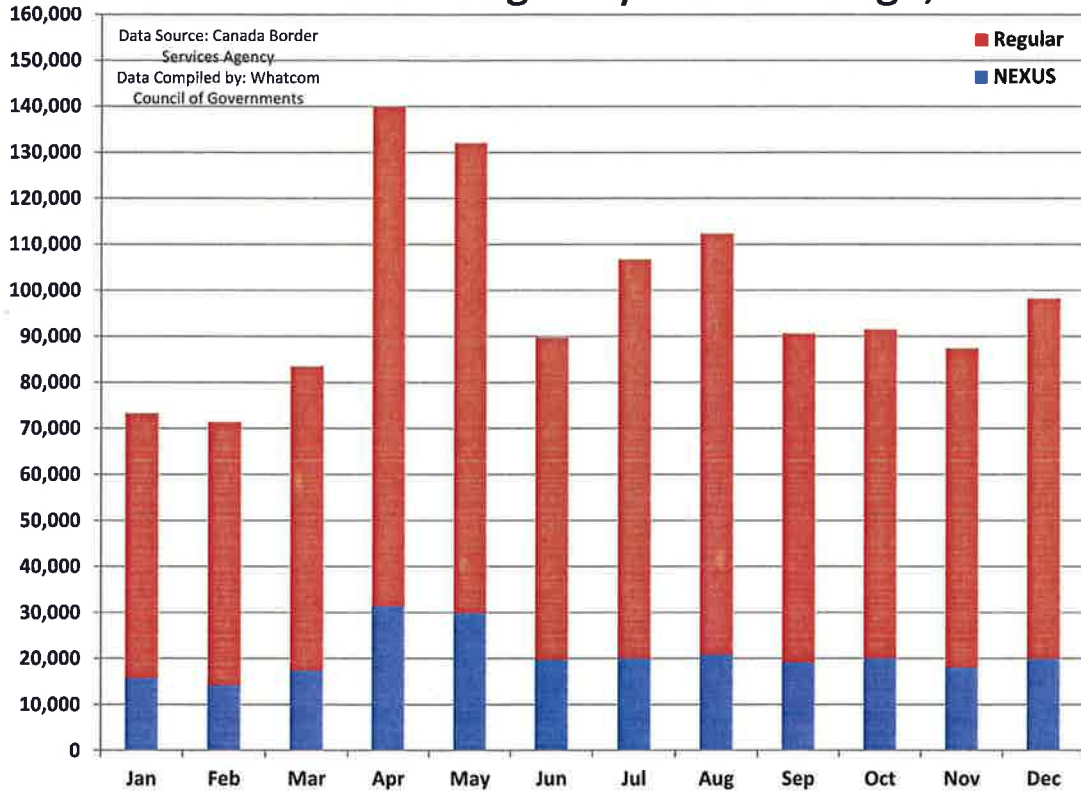

Northbound Douglas NEXUS Usage, 2010

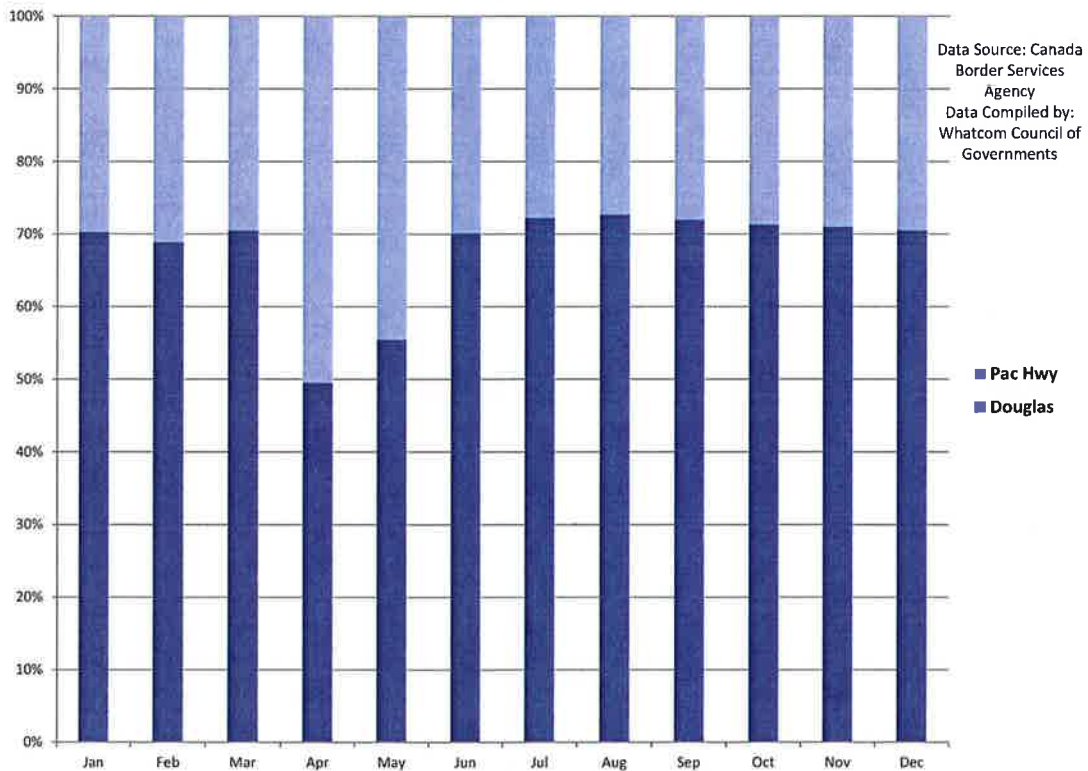

Northbound Pacific Highway NEXUS Usage, 2010

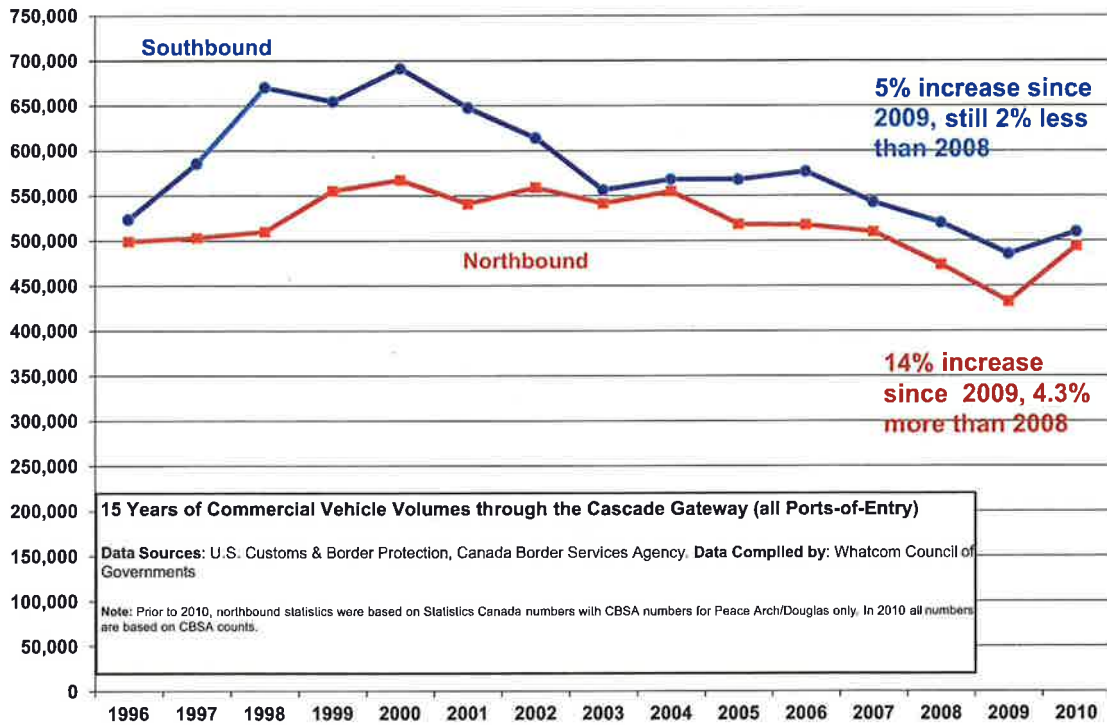


Northbound NEXUS split between ports , 2010

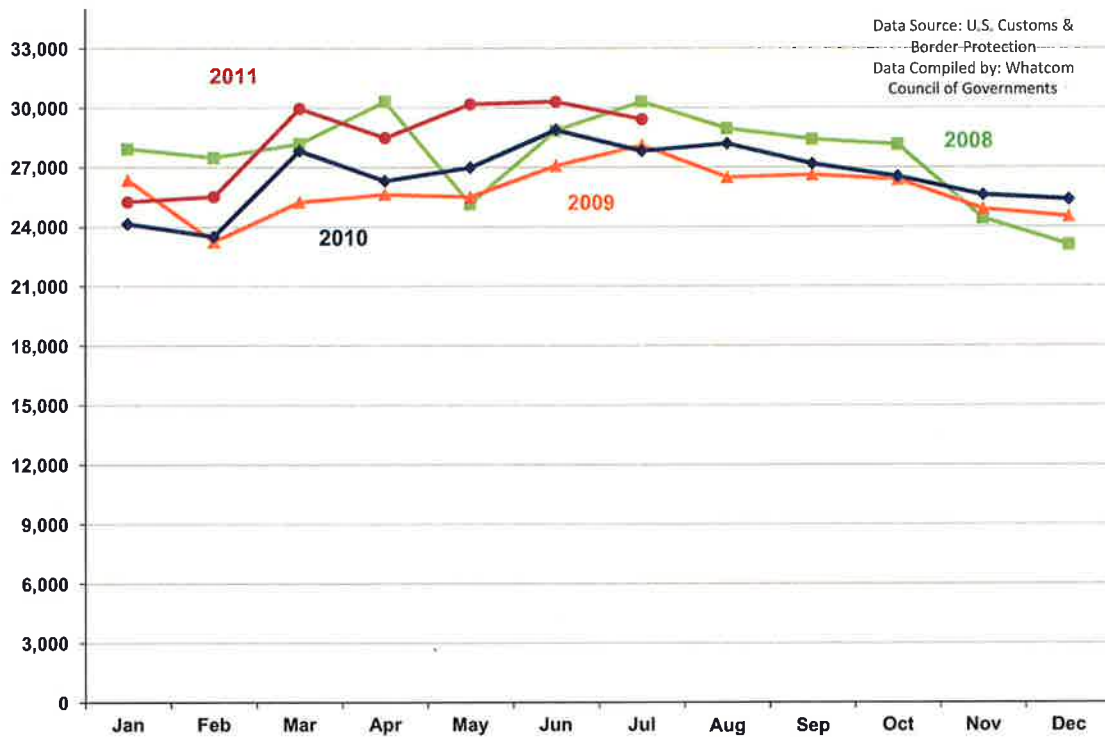


15 Years of Commercial Volumes

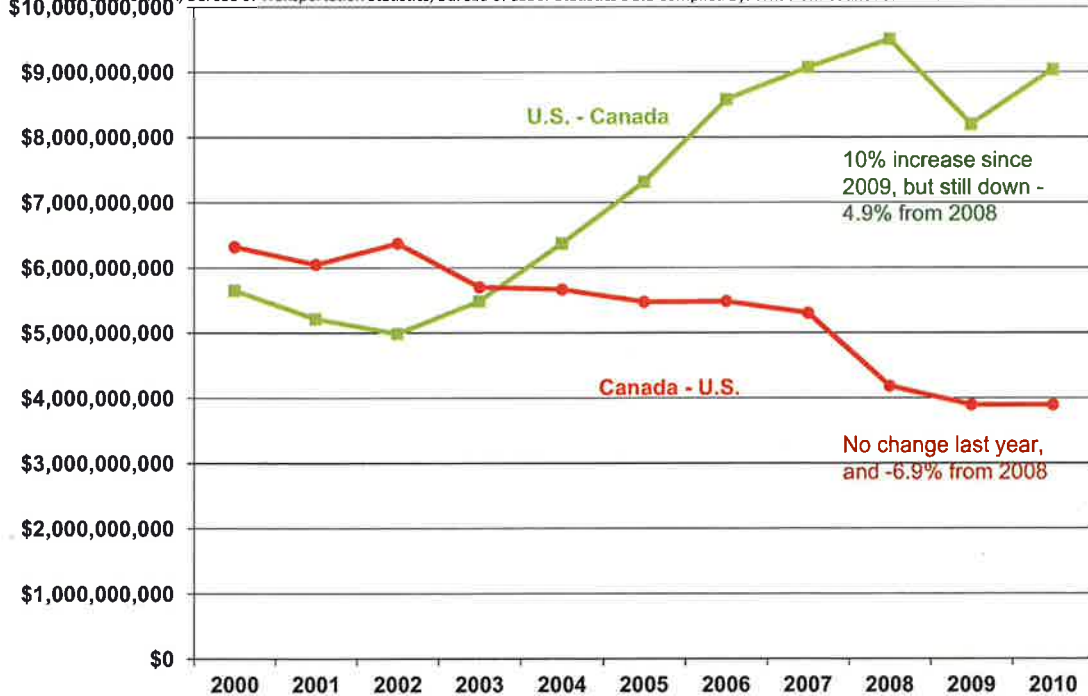
