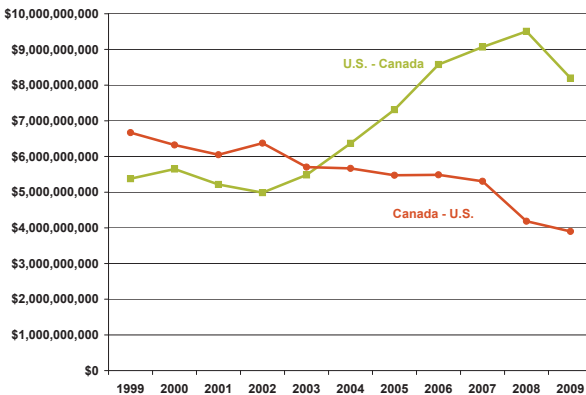


THE CASCADE GATEWAY

U.S. - CANADA TRADE VALUE BY MODE

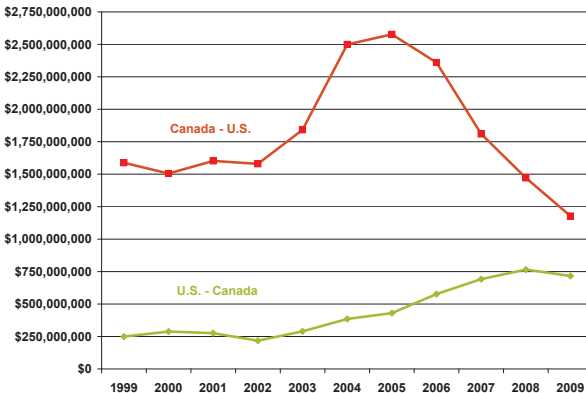
